Instructions to the Applicant

1. The following material must be filed with the Chairman of the Worcester Chapter AHEPA Scholarship Committee **BEFORE MAY 1st**
 - A. Application form completed in full (form attached)
 - B. Transcript of grades from high school (all 4 years)
 - C. Transcript of grades from college (if presently a college student)
 - D. Verification of Eligibility Form (attached)
 - E. Results of College Board Examinations (high school seniors only)
2. It is the responsibility of the applicant to gather all the forms and records required and submit them to the Chairman of the Worcester Chapter AHEPA Scholarship Committee **BEFORE THE MAY 1st**.
3. The five Worcester AHEPA Chapter Scholarship Awards are:

 - B. \$1000 AHEPA Chapter # 80 Award
 - C. \$1000 AHEPA Chapter # 80 Award

DEADLINE FOR FILING – MAY 1st

General information for the Applicant

1. Eligibility

- a. Applicant must be a member of the Maids of Athena, Sons of Pericles, or have a parent in the Order of AHEPA, Daughters of Penelope Chapters in Worcester, MA.
- b. A son or daughter of an Ahepan or Daughter of Penelope who has died and was a member in good standing of the Worcester Chapters at the time of death is eligible to apply.
- c. Applicant must have been accepted for admission or be enrolled in an accredited **four year** College or University for undergraduate studies for the coming year. High school seniors and undergraduate students may apply.
- d. Applicant must maintain a minimum 3.0 GPA or equivalent

2. Recipients of awards will be selected on the basis of scholastic achievement, financial need, character and his or her extra-curricular activities.

3. The Scholarship Award will be sent directly to the student upon receipt of written notice that the student winner of an AHEPA Award has been enrolled in the College or University.

- a. Award monies are to be used for tuition, room and board, books, lab fees and any other directly related college expenses only.
- b. If the student does NOT enroll or complete the first semester of the year of the Scholarship Award, all refunds, in part or in whole as pertains to the award will be made to Order of AHEPA, Peter L. Bell Chapter #80.

4. Scholarship Awards are for the coming College / University academic year beginning in September.

5. Previous winners of a Worcester Chapter AHEPA Scholarship award are not eligible to apply for an award again.

SCHOLARSHIP FUND, CHAPTER BY-LAWS Attachment C

The Worcester Order of AHEPA established a program which awards scholarships to eligible students who will attend an accredited college/university for undergraduate studies. A student is eligible to apply for scholarship awards if any of the following conditions are met:

1. The student is a member in good standing* of the Worcester AHEPA, Daughters of Penelope, Sons of Pericles or Maids of Athena.
2. The student is a son or daughter of a member in good standing* of the Worcester chapter of the Order of AHEPA, or the Worcester chapter of the Daughters of Penelope.
3. The student is orphaned and his or her legal guardian is a member in good standing* of the Worcester chapter of the Order of AHEPA, or the Worcester chapter of the Daughters of Penelope.
4. The student's parent(s) died and was (were) member's in good standing* of the Worcester chapter of the Order of AHEPA, or the Worcester chapter of the Daughters of Penelope at the time of their death(s). The student is eligible to apply thereafter.
5. The student may receive only one scholarship award in his/her lifetime.

*a member in good standing is one who has paid their financial dues to their organization for the past four (4) years and is current in the year in which application is submitted
